60 students begin with a **4-week Summer Institute** 

focused on developing skills and understanding of data science, and designed through equity and justice lenses.

All students join AMNH research labs for the academic year and work with Museum researchers on projects connected with ongoing research in astrophysics. anthropology, and biology for 260 hours. Students meet monthly at advisories focused on science communication, equity in STEM,
